PASTOR'S LETTER:

I hate waiting.

Maybe hate's too strong a word. But I am not patient. Waiting for the cable guy. Waiting in line for the cashier. Waiting at the traffic light. Waiting for Christmas. Waiting for test results. Waiting for my plane to take off. Waiting for my illness to go away. Waiting for the baby to get here. Waiting for the show to start. Waiting for the girls to get in the car so we can leave for school before the traffic gets heavy. Waiting for inspiration. Waiting for it to end. Waiting to see what happens. Waiting to wake up. Waiting to die. Waiting for no good reason.

Seems like we spend an inordinate amount of time waiting. I dare say I've spent more time waiting in my lifetime than sleep.

Given that that's even half true, it strikes me that waiting must be a part of the created order. In other words, God meant for us to be waiting. And if that's so, I've got to change how I speak about waiting.

I've heard it said—I've said it many times myself—that waiting is a waste of time. If God intended that we should wait then that can't be true. Maybe the real waste is what I do (or don't) with the time I'm having to wait. Instead of trying to fill the space with something, what if I just take that time and rest my mind? Instead of trying to cram everything in the world into every second what if I'm more intentional with actually scheduling times to wait, to ponder, to pray and listen.

I know that I'm impatient for things I'm doing to get results. I want my strength to increase instantly. I want to know things immediately. I want to get where I'm going yesterday and have what I need the moment I think of it. Maybe computers have accelerated the demise of ability to wait. But in the end, would having all of those things really be good? There's something beautiful in the work that must be put in to take care of one's body. There's something powerful about the pursuit of knowledge and the work it takes to attain it. There's something marvelous about fasting and denial that reminds us of what we really need and to appreciate what we have. There's something hopeful about having to take the journey to a place different than who or where you are.

So when Isaiah talks about waiting, we should pay close attention. Isaiah talks about on whom we are waiting. And the audience he's talking to is the people in Exile: the people of God forcibly removed from the Promised Land and left wondering if God had abandoned them. In Isaiah's



estimation, the key to waiting is relying on the history, knowledge, power and tirelessness of God, not ourselves. In other words, trusting God leads to strength, discovery, to hope. Waiting leads to hope.

That seems wrong.

It does until I think of our history. When I did strength and endurance training for wrestling, I remember the coach saying, "Wait until you see the results of your training! You won't believe what you can do." He was right. I ended up performing well enough to place 7th among all the DODDS students living in Germany at the time. Considering it was my first year, 7th out of more than 150 competitors felt like a true accomplishment. But more than that, a regimen that I thought impossible for me became routine. I'm glad I waited.

I can remember waiting and reserving judgment on coming to Mebane. Even though on paper there were a number of reasons to look elsewhere, God made me wait. And I thank God because what I have learned about this place, about all of you, about myself, have all been worth it. Waiting, divine patience, brings good things.

So when I'm frustrated that I'm not learning fast enough, working hard enough, speaking loud enough, loving widely enough, hearing well enough, I will wait... that the power of God will become routine rather than occasional to my faith.

Wait with me.

SESSION UPDATES

There are several highlights from the work of your leadership. Complete approved minutes of meetings and monthly financial statements are available from the Church Office to anyone. And by and large, the Session Meetings themselves are public. Anyone can address the Session upon request to the Moderator (David Ealy) (That's to make sure there's adequate time allotted). Above all else, every member should be praying for your leadership.

Examining the Elders Elect is a fiduciary responsibility the Session takes on behalf of all of us but especially on behalf of God. Determining our corporate officers and committee assignments helps maintain continuity with our work and to concretely take responsibility for God's call on us as a church. It's not enough to say that God calls us to be the church. People have to actually try. And your Session is doing more than just try.

Both given the current climate and the fact that it goes on demonstrably in our congregation, the Session put together a statement against Sexual Harassment and assigned a task force (being led by Debby Ferrell) to come up with concrete ways we can address this problem interpersonally and as a church. The statement is as follows:

"Hawfields Presbyterian Church states sexual harassment in all its forms is wrong and against the will of God for us and for the world. Power should never be used to leverage abuse against another. God in Jesus Christ stands with those abused and so do we."

We also approved an Eagle project to install a flagpole memorial in the cemetery as well as construction of a community garden for a Girl Scout Gold project. Both of these programs (Boy & Girl Scouts) are strong in our church.

Representing Hawfields, we've talked with Samet Corporation about their possible future plans and how that might affect us as well as inviting several groups to make use of our space including the UNC Women's Glee Club, the Alamance Children's Theatre Summer Camp, and our ongoing relationship with Alcoholics Anonymous.

One change to the way we do business has been a practice called "Word, Share, Prayer." We split into small groups of three to four and read a particular Bible passage together. Then we talk about what the passage means to us and how it applies to our leadership/faith. Then we pray for one another. An example of one of the exercises we used is on page 3. Find a few folks (no more than four or five) and try it!

All of this is beside the personal challenges and triumphs in the lives of your leadership. For example, the job promotion of one to the health challenges of another. We have taken up the ancient of laying on hands and praying for each other.

It is my personal honor to work with these folks and be among them.






